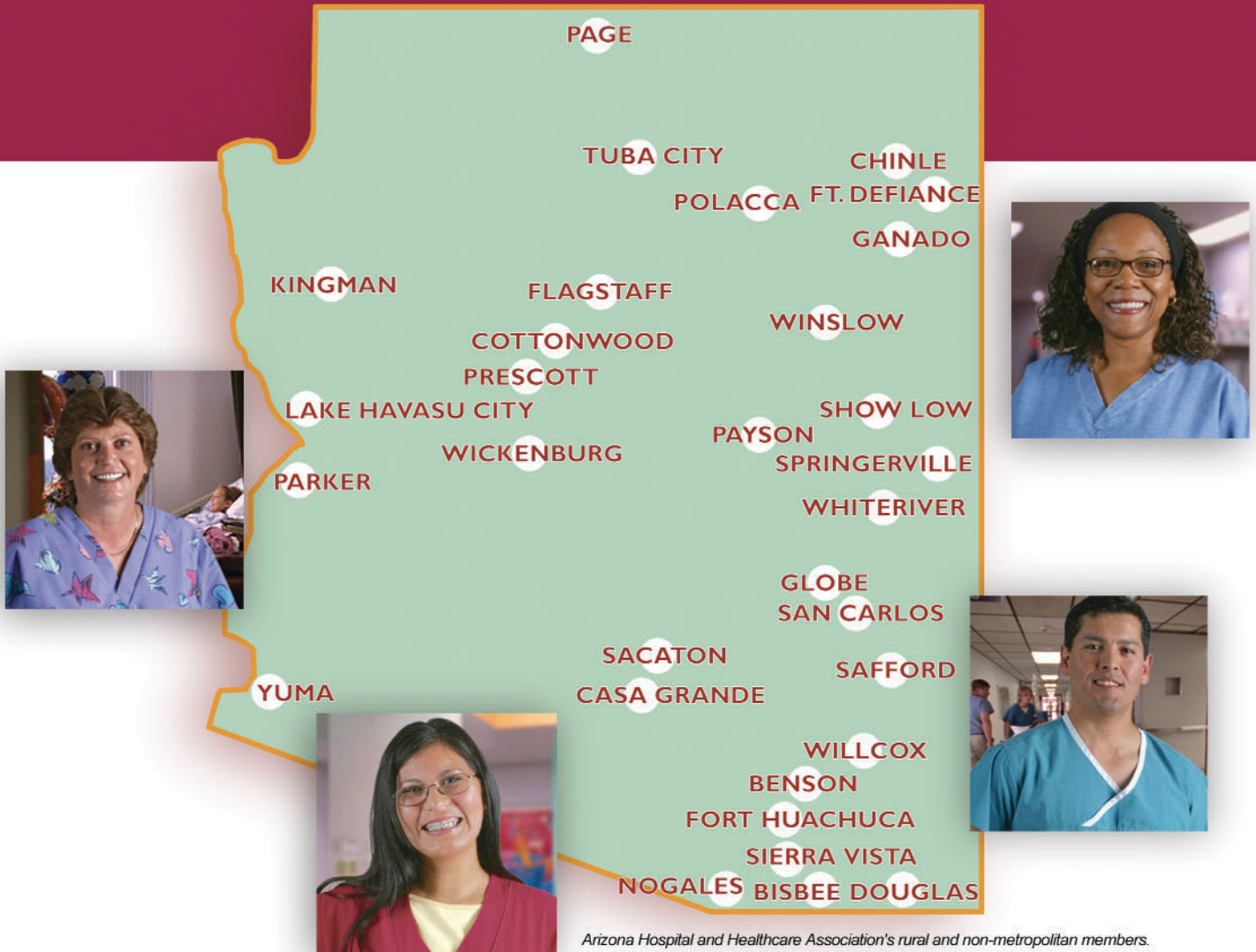


# Rural & Non-Metropolitan Healthcare: Delivering Value to Arizona
